BY DOING SO, SOCIAL WORKERS CAN ENGAGE IN PRACTICES THAT PROMOTE SOCIAL JUSTICE, CHALLENGE DISCRIMINATION, AND SUPPORT THE EMPOWERMENT OF MARGINALIZED GROUPS.

HISTORICAL CONTEXT AND DEVELOPMENT

EMPOWERMENT AND PARTICIPATION

EMPOWERMENT INVOLVES ENABLING CLIENTS TO GAIN CONTROL OVER THEIR LIVES AND DECISIONS. ANTI OPPRESSIVE SOCIAL WORK ENCOURAGES ACTIVE PARTICIPATION OF INDIVIDUALS AND COMMUNITIES IN THE PROCESSES THAT AFFECT THEM, FOSTERING SELF-DETERMINATION AND RESPECT FOR DIVERSE PERSPECTIVES.

CULTURAL COMPETENCE AND HUMILITY

PRACTITIONERS MUST DEVELOP CULTURAL COMPETENCE AND HUMILITY TO EFFECTIVELY ENGAGE WITH DIVERSE POPULATIONS. THIS ENTAILS UNDERSTANDING CULTURAL CONTEXTS, ACKNOWLEDGING ONE'S OWN BIASES, AND ADOPTING A RESPECTFUL AND OPEN-MINDED APPROACH TO DIFFERENT CULTURAL EXPERIENCES.

REFLEXIVITY AND CRITICAL SELF-AWARENESS

ANTI OPPRESSIVE SOCIAL WORK REQUIRES PRACTITIONERS TO CONTINUOUSLY REFLECT ON THEIR OWN VALUES, ASSUMPTIONS, AND POWER POSITIONS. REFLEXIVITY HELPS SOCIAL WORKERS RECOGNIZE HOW THEIR ACTIONS MAY EITHER PERPETUATE OR CHALLENGE OPPRESSION.

COLLABORATION AND ADVOCACY

COLLABORATION WITH CLIENTS, COMMUNITIES, AND OTHER PROFESSIONALS IS ESSENTIAL FOR ADDRESSING SYSTEMIC ISSUES. ADVOCACY EXTENDS BEYOND INDIVIDUAL CASES TO INCLUDE EFFORTS AIMED AT POLICY CHANGE AND SOCIAL REFORM.
