EMPRESS WU ZETIAN

PRINCESS TAIPING

MUSIC AND PERFORMING ARTS

WOMEN EXCELLED IN MUSIC AND DANCE, OFTEN SERVING AS PERFORMERS IN THE IMPERIAL COURT AND AT SOCIAL GATHERINGS. THESE ARTISTIC FORMS WERE INTEGRAL TO TANG CULTURAL LIFE, AND WOMEN'S PARTICIPATION ENRICHED THE ENTERTAINMENT AND CEREMONIAL TRADITIONS OF THE TIME.

FASHION AND AESTHETICS

SOCIAL STATUS AND DAILY LIFE

FAMILY AND MARRIAGE
