HISTORICAL THINKING SKILLS

THESE SKILLS ENABLE STUDENTS TO ENGAGE DEEPLY WITH HISTORICAL CONTENT AND PREPARE THEM FOR COLLEGE-LEVEL HISTORY COURSEWORK.

EXAM FORMAT AND STRUCTURE

THE AP US HISTORY EXAM IN 2023 CONTINUES TO CHALLENGE STUDENTS THROUGH A COMBINATION OF MULTIPLE-CHOICE QUESTIONS, SHORT-ANSWER QUESTIONS, A DOCUMENT-BASED QUESTION (DBQ), AND A LONG ESSAY QUESTION (LEQ). THE EXAM IS DESIGNED TO ASSESS BOTH CONTENT KNOWLEDGE AND CRITICAL THINKING ABILITIES, WITH A STRONG FOCUS ON HISTORICAL ANALYSIS AND INTERPRETATION.

MULTIPLE-CHOICE SECTION

THE MULTIPLE-CHOICE SECTION TYPICALLY CONSISTS OF APPROXIMATELY 55 QUESTIONS THAT COVER A BROAD SPECTRUM OF AMERICAN HISTORY. THESE QUESTIONS TEST STUDENTS' RECALL OF FACTUAL INFORMATION AS WELL AS THEIR ABILITY TO ANALYZE HISTORICAL DOCUMENTS, GRAPHS, MAPS, AND OTHER SOURCES. TIME MANAGEMENT AND CAREFUL READING ARE ESSENTIAL TO PERFORM WELL IN THIS SECTION.

SHORT-ANSWER QUESTIONS

THE SHORT-ANSWER SECTION REQUIRES STUDENTS TO RESPOND TO THREE QUESTIONS THAT INVOLVE INTERPRETING HISTORICAL SOURCES AND CONSTRUCTING CONCISE, EVIDENCE-BASED ANSWERS. THIS COMPONENT EMPHASIZES THE ABILITY TO ANALYZE PRIMARY SOURCES AND RELATE THEM TO BROADER HISTORICAL CONTEXTS.

DOCUMENT-BASED QUESTION (DBQ)

THE DBQ IS A CRITICAL PART OF THE AP US HISTORY 2023 EXAM, ASKING STUDENTS TO FORMULATE AN ARGUMENT BASED ON A SET OF PROVIDED HISTORICAL DOCUMENTS. LONG ESSAY QUESTION (LEQ)

THESE PROMPTS FOCUS ON SIGNIFICANT THEMES OR DEVELOPMENTS IN AMERICAN HISTORY AND REQUIRE STUDENTS TO CONSTRUCT A COHERENT ARGUMENT SUPPORTED BY RELEVANT HISTORICAL EVIDENCE. TIME MANAGEMENT AND ESSAY ORGANIZATION ARE KEY FACTORS FOR SUCCESS.

KEY HISTORICAL THEMES AND PERIODS
