ORIGINS AND EARLY DEVELOPMENT OF BALLET

IT'S A VALUABLE RESOURCE FOR UNDERSTANDING BALLET'S MODERNIST TURN.

8. *INSIDE BALLET TECHNIQUE: SEPARATING ANATOMICAL FACT FROM FICTION IN THE BALLET CLASS* BY VALERIE GRIEG

GRIEG OFFERS AN ANATOMICALLY INFORMED APPROACH TO BALLET TECHNIQUE, HELPING DANCERS AND TEACHERS IMPROVE PERFORMANCE AND REDUCE INJURY. THE BOOK CHALLENGES COMMON MISCONCEPTIONS ABOUT BALLET TRAINING AND PROVIDES PRACTICAL ADVICE GROUNDED IN SCIENCE. IT'S A USEFUL COMPLEMENT TO HISTORICAL AND ARTISTIC STUDIES OF BALLET.

9. *DANCE: A VERY SHORT INTRODUCTION* BY SONDRA HORTON FRALEIGH

THIS CONCISE INTRODUCTION COVERS THE BROAD SPECTRUM OF DANCE, INCLUDING BALLET, FROM CULTURAL, HISTORICAL, AND THEORETICAL PERSPECTIVES. FRALEIGH ADDRESSES DANCE AS A FORM OF HUMAN EXPRESSION AND COMMUNICATION. THE BOOK SITUATES BALLET WITHIN THE LARGER CONTEXT OF GLOBAL DANCE TRADITIONS AND PRACTICES.

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
