ARE WITCHES AND WIZARDS REAL HAS BEEN A QUESTION THAT CAPTURES THE CURIOSITY AND IMAGINATION OF MANY THROUGHOUT HISTORY AND ACROSS CULTURES. FOLKLORE AND MYTHOLOGY

WIZARDS AND SORCERERS IN MYTH

WIZARDS ARE TYPICALLY PORTRAYED AS MALE MAGIC USERS POSSESSING DEEP KNOWLEDGE OF ARCANE ARTS. FIGURES SUCH AS MERLIN FROM ARTHURIAN LEGEND SYMBOLIZE WISDOM, GUIDANCE, AND MYSTICAL POWER. ACROSS CULTURES, SORCERERS OFTEN SERVE AS ADVISORS, PROTECTORS, OR ANTAGONISTS IN MYTHS AND LEGENDS. THEIR MAGICAL ABILITIES ARE DEPICTED AS LEARNED SKILLS RATHER THAN INNATE POWERS, HIGHLIGHTING THE THEME OF KNOWLEDGE AS A FORM OF POWER.

WITCH HUNTS AND TRIALS
