SUPPORTING EVIDENCE

PROVIDING CREDIBLE AND RELEVANT EVIDENCE TO BACK UP THE CLAIM IS ESSENTIAL. COUNTERARGUMENTS AND REBUTTALS

ADDRESSING OPPOSING VIEWPOINTS STRENGTHENS AN ARGUMENTATIVE ESSAY BY DEMONSTRATING CRITICAL THINKING AND FAIRNESS. THE ANCHOR CHART OUTLINES HOW TO ACKNOWLEDGE COUNTERARGUMENTS RESPECTFULLY AND REFUTE THEM WITH LOGICAL REASONING AND EVIDENCE.

ORGANIZATION AND STRUCTURE

A CLEAR AND LOGICAL ORGANIZATION ENHANCES THE READABILITY AND IMPACT OF THE ESSAY. THE CHART SHOULD DEPICT THE TYPICAL STRUCTURE OF AN ARGUMENTATIVE ESSAY, INCLUDING THE INTRODUCTION WITH A HOOK AND THESIS, BODY PARAGRAPHS WITH EVIDENCE AND REBUTTALS, AND A STRONG CONCLUSION.

USING TRANSITIONAL LANGUAGE HELPS TO CONNECT IDEAS SMOOTHLY AND GUIDE THE READER THROUGH THE ARGUMENT. THE ANCHOR CHART SHOULD PROVIDE EXAMPLES OF EFFECTIVE TRANSITION WORDS AND PHRASES THAT FACILITATE COHERENCE AND FLOW.

WRITING STYLE AND TONE

THE CHART MAY ALSO HIGHLIGHT THE IMPORTANCE OF MAINTAINING A FORMAL, OBJECTIVE TONE APPROPRIATE FOR ARGUMENTATIVE WRITING, AVOIDING SLANG OR OVERLY EMOTIONAL LANGUAGE.

HOW TO CREATE A COMPREHENSIVE ARGUMENTATIVE WRITING ANCHOR CHART
