ORIGINS AND BACKGROUND OF DO ANDROIDS DREAM OF ELECTRIC SHEEP?

PHILIP K. DICK'S NOVEL *DO ANDROIDS DREAM OF ELECTRIC SHEEP?* WAS FIRST PUBLISHED IN 1968 AND IS CONSIDERED A LANDMARK WORK IN THE SCIENCE FICTION GENRE. SET IN A POST-APOCALYPTIC FUTURE, THE NOVEL EXPLORES A BLEAK WORLD WHERE EARTH HAS SUFFERED CATASTROPHIC DAMAGE FROM A NUCLEAR WAR. THE STORY FOCUSES ON THE BLURRED LINES BETWEEN HUMANS AND ANDROIDS—ARTIFICIALLY CREATED BEINGS THAT ARE NEARLY INDISTINGUISHABLE FROM HUMANS. BLADE RUNNER: THE FILM ADAPTATION

HEAVILY FROM THE BOOK'S CORE CONCEPTS, THE MOVIE INTRODUCES SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN TONE, CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT, AND VISUAL STYLE. THE FILM IS RENOWNED FOR ITS DYSTOPIAN DEPICTION OF LOS ANGELES IN 2019, COMBINING NOIR AESTHETICS WITH CYBERPUNK ELEMENTS.
