ORIGINS AND EARLY DEVELOPMENT OF CARTOON HISTORY

THE CARTOON HISTORY OF THE UNITED STATES TRACES ITS ROOTS BACK TO THE 18TH AND 19TH CENTURIES WHEN POLITICAL CARTOONS BEGAN APPEARING IN NEWSPAPERS AND PAMPHLETS. THESE WORKS NOT ONLY REFLECTED HISTORICAL EVENTS BUT ALSO HELPED TO DEFINE THE CULTURAL MEMORY OF THE ERA.

EVOLUTION OF STYLE AND MEDIUM
