THIS CASE PROVIDED EARLY EVIDENCE LINKING BRAIN FUNCTION TO PERSONALITY TRAITS AND EMOTIONAL REGULATION, SIGNIFICANTLY INFLUENCING NEUROPSYCHOLOGY AND THE UNDERSTANDING OF BRAIN-BEHAVIOR RELATIONSHIPS.

THE CASE OF GENIE: LANGUAGE DEPRIVATION AND DEVELOPMENT

GENIE WAS A YOUNG GIRL SUBJECTED TO EXTREME SOCIAL ISOLATION AND LANGUAGE DEPRIVATION. HER CASE HIGHLIGHTED THE CRITICAL PERIODS OF LANGUAGE ACQUISITION AND THE IMPACT OF ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS ON COGNITIVE AND PSYCHOLOGICAL DEVELOPMENT. IT ALSO RAISED IMPORTANT QUESTIONS ABOUT RECOVERY POTENTIAL FOLLOWING SEVERE NEGLECT AND ABUSE.

THE CASE OF ANNA O. AND THE ORIGINS OF PSYCHOANALYSIS

ANNA O., TREATED BY JOSEF BREUER, WAS A PIVOTAL CASE IN THE EMERGENCE OF PSYCHOANALYTIC THEORY. HER SYMPTOMS OF HYSTERIA AND THE THERAPEUTIC APPROACH USED IN HER TREATMENT LAID THE GROUNDWORK FOR SIGMUND FREUD'S DEVELOPMENT OF PSYCHOANALYSIS, EMPHASIZING THE UNCONSCIOUS MIND AND THE ROLE OF REPRESSED MEMORIES.

METHODOLOGIES USED IN PSYCHOLOGICAL CASE STUDIES

RESEARCHERS MUST ALSO NAVIGATE THE BALANCE BETWEEN SCIENTIFIC INQUIRY AND THERAPEUTIC BENEFIT, AVOIDING EXPLOITATION OR HARM. ETHICAL REVIEW BOARDS TYPICALLY OVERSEE CASE STUDY PROPOSALS TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS AND LEGAL REQUIREMENTS.
