COMMON ETHICAL DILEMMAS IN NURSING

NURSES FREQUENTLY ENCOUNTER ETHICAL DILEMMAS THAT REQUIRE BALANCING COMPETING RESPONSIBILITIES AND VALUES.

NURSES MUST NAVIGATE SITUATIONS WHERE PATIENTS REFUSE TREATMENT OR MAKE DECISIONS THAT MAY NOT ALIGN WITH MEDICAL ADVICE, BALANCING RESPECT FOR THEIR RIGHTS WITH THE OBLIGATION TO PROVIDE BENEFICENT CARE.

CONFIDENTIALITY AND PRIVACY

MAINTAINING PATIENT CONFIDENTIALITY IS A CORNERSTONE OF NURSING ETHICS. HOWEVER, DILEMMAS ARISE WHEN SHARING INFORMATION IS NECESSARY FOR THE PATIENT'S SAFETY OR PUBLIC HEALTH CONCERNS. NURSES MUST CAREFULLY CONSIDER LEGAL REQUIREMENTS AND ETHICAL PRINCIPLES WHEN HANDLING SENSITIVE DATA.

END-OF-LIFE CARE DECISIONS

ETHICAL ISSUES SURROUNDING END-OF-LIFE CARE OFTEN INVOLVE DECISIONS ABOUT LIFE-SUSTAINING TREATMENTS, PALLIATIVE CARE, AND ADVANCE DIRECTIVES. NURSES PLAY A CRITICAL ROLE IN ADVOCATING FOR PATIENT WISHES WHILE SUPPORTING FAMILIES AND HEALTHCARE TEAMS THROUGH THESE EMOTIONALLY CHARGED SITUATIONS.

RESOURCE ALLOCATION AND JUSTICE

FAIR DISTRIBUTION OF LIMITED HEALTHCARE RESOURCES PRESENTS ETHICAL CHALLENGES IN NURSING. NURSES MAY FACE DILEMMAS ABOUT PRIORITIZING CARE AMONG PATIENTS, REQUIRING ADHERENCE TO PRINCIPLES OF JUSTICE AND EQUITY.

METHODOLOGIES FOR ANALYZING NURSING ETHICS CASE STUDIES

USE OF INTERDISCIPLINARY ETHICS COMMITTEES

COMPLEX CASES MAY BENEFIT FROM CONSULTATION WITH ETHICS COMMITTEES COMPRISING HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS, LEGAL ADVISORS, AND ETHICISTS. THESE COMMITTEES OFFER DIVERSE PERSPECTIVES AND SUPPORT COLLABORATIVE DECISION-MAKING.
