FOUNDATIONS OF CATHOLIC SOCIAL JUSTICE

THE FOUNDATIONS OF CATHOLIC SOCIAL JUSTICE LIE IN THE CHURCH'S COMMITMENT TO UPHOLD HUMAN DIGNITY, PROMOTE THE COMMON GOOD, AND ADVOCATE FOR EQUITABLE TREATMENT OF ALL PEOPLE. THESE FOUNDATIONS ARE DEEPLY ROOTED IN THE TEACHINGS OF JESUS CHRIST AND THE CHURCH'S TRADITION, EMPHASIZING THE RESPONSIBILITY OF INDIVIDUALS AND COMMUNITIES TO WORK TOWARDS A JUST SOCIETY. CATHOLIC SOCIAL JUSTICE ADDRESSES SYSTEMIC INEQUALITIES, POVERTY, AND INJUSTICE WHILE ENCOURAGING SOLIDARITY AND RESPECT FOR HUMAN RIGHTS. UNDERSTANDING THESE FOUNDATIONS OFFERS CLARITY ON WHY THE CHURCH PRIORITIZES SOCIAL JUSTICE AND HOW IT INTEGRATES FAITH WITH ACTION.

THESE DOCUMENTS FORM THE BACKBONE OF THE CHURCH'S SOCIAL JUSTICE FRAMEWORK, PRESENTING ANSWERS TO ETHICAL DILEMMAS AND SOCIAL ISSUES.

ROLE OF THE CHURCH IN SOCIETY

THE CATHOLIC CHURCH VIEWS ITSELF AS A MORAL GUIDE AND ADVOCATE FOR JUSTICE IN THE PUBLIC SPHERE. THIS RESPONSIBILITY IS A PRACTICAL EXTENSION OF THE CHURCH'S MISSION TO SERVE BOTH SPIRITUAL AND TEMPORAL NEEDS.

CORE PRINCIPLES OF CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING

CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING IS STRUCTURED AROUND SEVERAL KEY PRINCIPLES THAT PROVIDE A MORAL COMPASS FOR ADDRESSING SOCIAL JUSTICE ISSUES. - **DIGNITY OF THE HUMAN PERSON:** EVERY PERSON IS CREATED IN THE IMAGE OF GOD AND DESERVES RESPECT AND PROTECTION.
- **COMMON GOOD:** THE SOCIAL CONDITIONS THAT ALLOW INDIVIDUALS AND COMMUNITIES TO FLOURISH COLLECTIVELY.
- **SOLIDARITY:** A COMMITMENT TO STAND WITH AND SUPPORT THOSE WHO ARE VULNERABLE OR OPPRESSED.
- **SUBSIDIARITY:** DECISIONS SHOULD BE MADE AT THE MOST LOCAL LEVEL POSSIBLE, EMPOWERING INDIVIDUALS AND COMMUNITIES.
- **OPTION FOR THE POOR AND VULNERABLE:** PRIORITIZING THE NEEDS OF THE MARGINALIZED IN SOCIAL POLICIES AND ACTIONS.
- **RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:** EVERYONE HAS FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS THAT MUST BE RESPECTED ALONGSIDE CORRESPONDING DUTIES.
- **STEWARDSHIP OF CREATION:** CARE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AS A MORAL OBLIGATION TOWARD FUTURE GENERATIONS.

UNDERSTANDING HUMAN DIGNITY

HUMAN DIGNITY IS THE CORNERSTONE OF CATHOLIC SOCIAL JUSTICE. IT AFFIRMS THAT EVERY INDIVIDUAL, REGARDLESS OF SOCIAL STATUS OR BACKGROUND, POSSESSES AN INHERENT WORTH THAT DEMANDS PROTECTION AND RESPECT. THIS PRINCIPLE UNDERLIES THE CHURCH'S OPPOSITION TO DISCRIMINATION, EXPLOITATION, AND INJUSTICE IN ALL FORMS. PROTECTING HUMAN DIGNITY REQUIRES JUST SOCIAL STRUCTURES AND PERSONAL ETHICS THAT UPHOLD THE SANCTITY OF LIFE AND HUMAN RIGHTS.

EMPHASIS ON SOLIDARITY AND COMMON GOOD

SOLIDARITY REINFORCES THE INTERCONNECTEDNESS OF ALL PEOPLE, ENCOURAGING COMPASSIONATE SUPPORT AND COLLECTIVE RESPONSIBILITY. THE COMMON GOOD, MEANWHILE, FOCUSES ON CREATING SOCIETAL CONDITIONS WHERE ALL MEMBERS CAN ACHIEVE THEIR POTENTIAL. CATHOLIC SOCIAL JUSTICE TEACHES THAT TRUE SOCIAL PROGRESS RESPECTS BOTH INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS AND COMMUNITY WELFARE, BALANCING PERSONAL FREEDOMS WITH SOCIAL OBLIGATIONS.

BIBLICAL AND THEOLOGICAL BASIS FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE

SCRIPTURAL FOUNDATIONS

NUMEROUS BIBLICAL TEXTS SERVE AS FOUNDATIONAL REFERENCES FOR CATHOLIC SOCIAL JUSTICE. FOR EXAMPLE, THE OLD TESTAMENT PROPHETS CALL FOR JUSTICE AND MERCY, WHILE THE TEACHINGS OF JESUS EMPHASIZE LOVE FOR NEIGHBOR AND

PREFERENTIAL CONCERN FOR THE MARGINALIZED. PASSAGES SUCH AS MATTHEW 25:31-46 HIGHLIGHT THE IMPORTANCE OF SERVING “THE LEAST OF THESE” AS A CRITERION FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS. THESE SCRIPTURES FORM A MORAL IMPERATIVE GUIDING BELIEVERS’ SOCIAL ACTIONS.

THEOLOGY OF JUSTICE AND CHARITY

THEOLOGY DISTINGUISHES BETWEEN JUSTICE AND CHARITY AS COMPLEMENTARY VIRTUES ESSENTIAL TO SOCIAL ETHICS. JUSTICE INVOLVES GIVING EACH PERSON THEIR DUE IN TERMS OF RIGHTS AND SOCIAL STRUCTURES, WHILE CHARITY PERTAINS TO PERSONAL ACTS OF LOVE AND MERCY. PROMOTING HUMAN RIGHTS AND PEACE

THE CHURCH PROMOTES SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT, RESPONSIBLE CONSUMPTION, AND PROTECTION OF NATURAL RESOURCES AS MORAL DUTIES. THIS APPROACH LINKS ECOLOGICAL CONCERNS WITH THE WELLBEING OF VULNERABLE POPULATIONS DISPROPORTIONATELY AFFECTED BY ENVIRONMENTAL DEGRADATION.
